After forming a creative agency in New York City, he focused on advertising and commercial art and was regularly commissioned by clients such as Nike, Versace and even Barack Obama.

He makes them with freehand spray paint on a colossal scale. His work can be found in cities from Paris to Shanghai and is part of the Museum of Modern Art's (MoMA) permanent collection.
